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1. INTRODUCTION

The German Championships (Deutsche Meisterschaften) in Wildwater Racing 2026 will take place in the Möll Valley (Mölltal), Carinthia, Austria, on the River Möll, across the municipalities of Obervellach and Reißbeck. The River Möll is a natural alpine river originating near the Grossglockner and offers high-quality conditions for elite wildwater competition in an outstanding mountain setting.

As part of the German Championships, the Paddle Europe Wildwater Cup Sprint (PEU Cup), a competition of the European Canoe Association (ECA), will also take place. Integrated into the 2026 Championships on the Möll River, the PEU Cup Sprint adds an international dimension and extra excitement to the event – for athletes, spectators and partners alike.

8. COMPETITION RULES, EQUIPMENT AND ATHLETE REQUIREMENTS

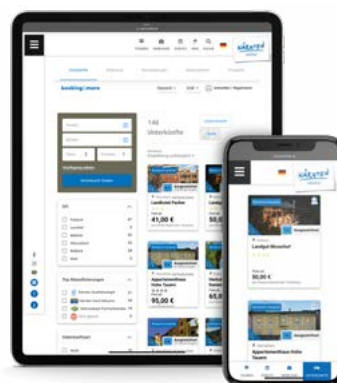
- The competitions are governed by the DKV competition rules for wildwater canoe racing and the PEU Cup rules.
- Mandatory equipment requirements, boat control procedures, race bib regulations and further safety requirements will be published on the event website and communicated during the Team Leaders' Meeting.

9. ACCOMMODATION AND TOURISM

Accommodation information is available through the regional tourism portal of the Möll Valley in Carinthia. Participants are recommended to book accommodation in Obervellach, Reißeck or the surrounding villages and communities (Penk, Teuchl, Napplach, Polan and Kolbnitz).

10. TRAVEL, TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

Detailed information on access routes, transportation and parking areas for athletes and team officials at the race courses will be published on the event website.

11. SAFETY, MEDICAL SERVICES AND EMERGENCIES

A comprehensive safety plan (water safety, rescue services, medical support and emergency procedures) will be issued prior to the event. Until then, participants should be aware of the following conditions:

- Natural mountain river conditions, including cold water, strong currents and potentially fluctuating water levels.
- Safety briefings are mandatory for Team Leaders and athletes.
- The section of the course from Obervellach to Penk is supervised by clubs both on the water and on land. From Penk to Kolbnitz, the LK race course is supervised by the Austrian Water Rescue Service (Kärnten Regional Association)
- The competition schedule and/or race courses may be modified, suspended or cancelled if conditions require.
- The current water level of the Möll River will be available on the event website: www.dm2026-moell.de.
